PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING

Chairman Manning opened the Public Hearing at 9:15am.

County Attorney, James Hill, stated that the purpose of the hearing is to request the approval of a Resolution to enter into a new Water Purchase Contract related to Coosa Valley Water Service District debt. Mr. Hill stated, that St. Clair County has been part of the original thirty (30) year warrant debt issued in 2009 that comes due in 2039. The time has come to refinance this debt without extending the maturity of the debt. This will simply save money for all members. It will be a Fifty (\$50,000.00) to Eighty (\$80,000.00) Thousand Dollars. This project serves as an economic commercial developmental purpose and also serves a public purpose. We are able to authorize and issue this debt pursuant to the Amendment 772. Part of this process is that it has to be noticed in the newspaper which has been done, we have noticed this meeting no less than 7 days and invited the Public and asked them to make comments. The only change to the contract that will affect us is that it will be moved to a Fiscal Year due to Budget Processing. The only other change is saving more money on the Debt. At this time, St. Clair County welcomes any public comment. If there are no comments we can close the meeting. James stated no one was on the phone with any comments. Mr. Hill's recommendation is for the commission to approve the request in the regular county commission today. There being no additional public comment, Chairman Manning closed the public hearing at 9:22 a.m.
