

RESOLUTION 2018-45

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING AND ENACTING SPECIAL ELECTION RESULTS

WHEREAS, Alabama Act No. 2015-45 (the "Act") provides that the governing body of a county, by resolution, may call an election to determine the sentiment of the voters residing within the unincorporated area of the county as to whether alcoholic beverages may be legally sold or distributed on Sunday within the unincorporated areas of the county; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, a special election for the unincorporated areas of St. Clair County, Alabama, was duly and legally held on June 5, 2018 wherein the following question was asked of the voters within the municipality: "Do you favor the legal sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages outside the corporate limits of any municipalities within the county on Sunday as further provided for and regulated by ordinance (or resolution) of the county commission? Yes ___ No ___."; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of St. Clair County, Alabama, met on this the 12 day of June, 2018 pursuant to the above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commission for St. Clair County, Alabama, as follows:

1. That the results of the aforementioned election (the "Election") are being certified on or about June 15, 2018.
2. That upon certification of the results of the Election, should the response "**YES**" receive a majority of the votes cast and, pursuant to Alabama Act No. 2015-45, sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages on Sundays outside the corporate limits of any municipalities within St. Clair County shall be immediately permitted by licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and St. Clair County serving the general public in accordance with applicable laws and regulations and as further provided for and regulated by the governing body.
