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The first item of business was to change the status of Aislinn Campbell, E-911 Director, from contract to a regular employee. On a motion by Commissioner Mize, seconded by Commissioner Bowers, with all voting aye, it was

RESOLVED, that Aislinn Campbell, E-911 Director, employment status be changed from a contract employee to a regular employee.

The next item of business was to approve a Letter of Support to INdigital granting Blount County E911 access to the MSAG records for the City of Leeds. On a motion by Commissioner Parker, seconded by Commissioner Brown, with all voting aye, it was
