**POLICY ON FINACIAL PARTICIPATION IN ATRIP II GRANTS FOR MUNICIPALITIES
WITHIN ST. CLAIR COUNTY**

St. Clair County encourages all municipalities within St. Clair County to pursue the annual ATRIP II Grant Program wherein ALDOT accepts applications for proposed projects to improve intersections or roads involving US or State Routes maintained by ALDOT. The program provides up to \$2,000,000.00 of funding from the Rebuild Alabama Act towards any approved project.

Projects applications do not require local funds but proposing to commit some amount of local funds may give such applications an advantage. The St. Clair County Commission will support any approved ATRIP II grant application by matching the local funds proposed by any municipality within St. Clair County up to a maximum of \$200,000.00. Stated differently, the County Commission will the lesser of the same amount of local funding being provided by the municipality toward the application / project and Two Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00). These funds would not be paid out until after the project is bid and a contract awarded to a contractor. Notwithstanding anything herein, the County reserves the right to contribute its "funds" by way of like-kind services to be paid in lieu of money.

The St. Clair County Commission will not serve as a co-sponsor on any ATRIP II grant application submitted by a municipality and will not be responsible for any overruns that may occur at the end of the project.
